Offer exposure to HR professionals and industry expectations through direct interactions.

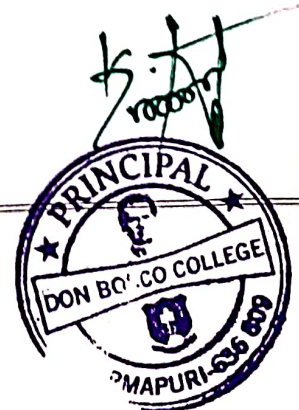
5. **Boost Confidence:**

Objective of the Programme:

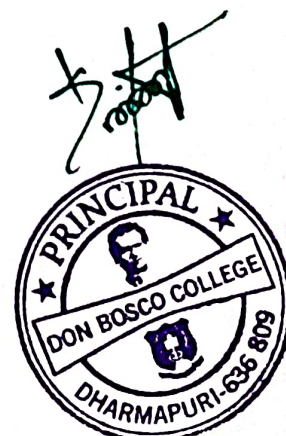
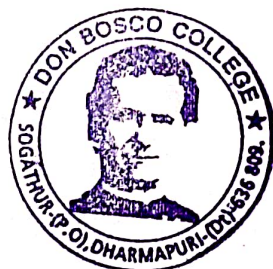

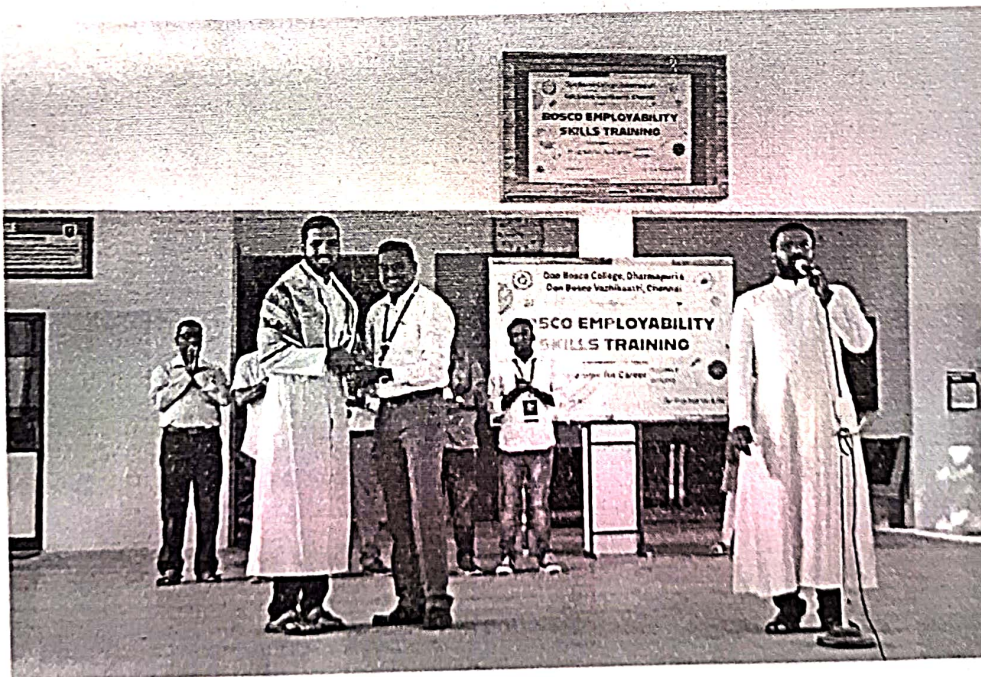
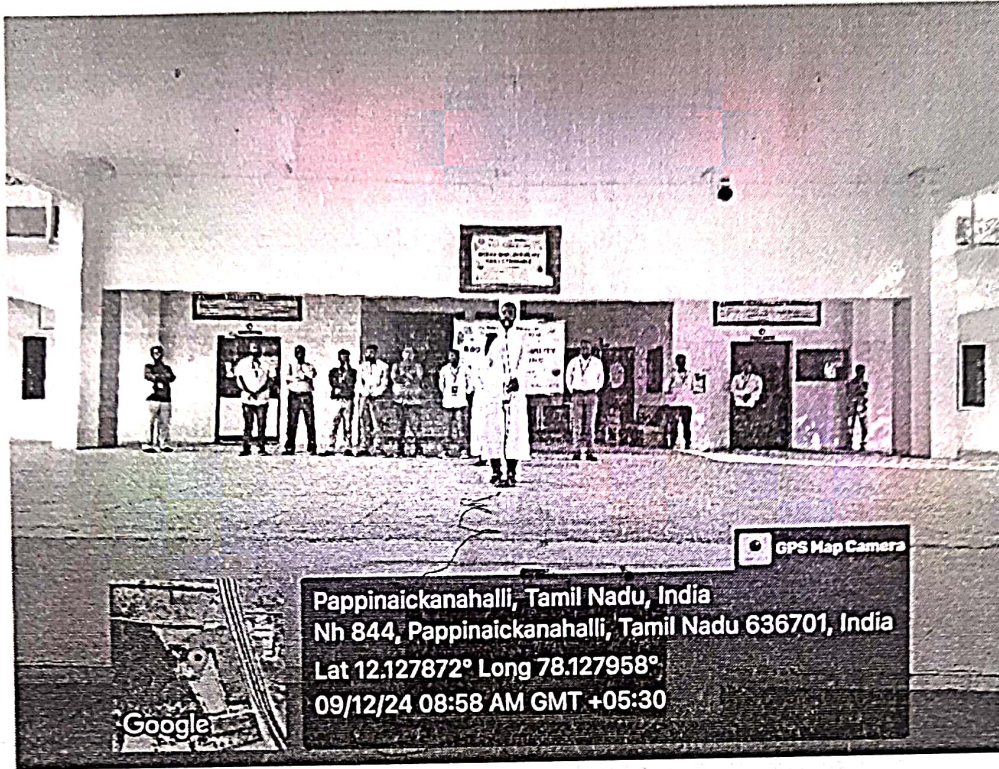
Learning Outcomes:
