
#### **BRIEF REPORT :**

The session was successfully ended with the vote of thanks given by our Department Association President, Mr.M.Sedhupathi.



Our beloved HOD Mr.D.Ramkumar, he gave a warm welcome to our judge to be amidst us.



### **Conclusion:**


