MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is signed on this day 6th May 2022 between **Values Vruksha Private Limited** a registered private limited company under the Companies Act, 2013 having its registered office at **No.2/122, First Floor, B-Block, Thanthondri Amman Koil Street, ECR-Uthandi, Chennai – 600 119** hereinafter called the "Training Partner" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, includes its successors and assignees of the Training Partner.

AND

Don Bosco College, situated at **2/257, Athiyaman Bypass Road, Sogathur Post, Dharmapuri - 636 809 Tamilnadu** represented by **The Principal**, hereinafter called the "Institution" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successors and assignees of the "Institution")

Nature of Collaboration:

WHERE AS both parties are united by common interests and objectives and are hereby agree to collaborate for the purpose of initiating, developing and implementing various students training programs such as GST Practitioner Training, Income Tax Practitioner Training, Stock Market Training, Entrepreneurship Training Program & Certified Accounting Professional etc., and the Institution agreeing to utilize its resources for conducting such training.

A. TRAINING PARTNER:

The Institution hereby authorizes (subject to meeting the eligibility requirements & the payment of prescribed fees & dues by Institution to Training Partner) the Training Partner to act as their External Trainer for a period of **Two years** initially, extendable to such periods as are recommended for approval by the Institution from time to time.

B. INSTITUTION:

The Institution will be responsible for providing the syllabi, curricula of the programs to be offered by the Institution for the conduct of training programs to be offered by the Training partner & to render monitoring/ guidance support to the Institution as an authorized Training Partner. The content, Syllabi, & curricula shall be designed, keeping in mind the Industry requirements.

The Institution will not add to, subtract from or substitute all or any of the above at a future date or alter the duration of training and / or number of trainees in its training courses without the approval of the Training partner. In all matters concerning training and certification under this scheme, the Institution shall provide the systems and procedures.

The Institution shall appoint a Jury from among the names recommended by the Institution to examine performance of the students training and issue certificates to the successful candidates trained under the approved programs. For all such examination the Institution shall compensate Jury members for their expertise and time devoted to this task, as per the fee structure decided by the Institution.

The Institution shall pay the fees as per the attached enclosure, which shall be treated as an integral part of this MoU.

The Training partner shall depute one observer with the Institution. The observer may participate the entire training programs & conducts the observation work on a regular basis. The Institution shall ensure the provision of resources of space, equipment, material and other facilities (Please refer annexure I) as required by the Training partner.



Activities to be carried out:

a) Develop Capability to deliver training in proposed sector/sectors

Training Partner shall make endeavours for nominating well experienced training faculty members for imparting training from amongst their existing or suitable external faculty members with appropriate skills and knowledge.

To meet the core training need, in line with industrial requirements, training partner shall make endeavours for enhancing the practical training systems, facilities, infrastructure (as per annexure I) and laboratories available with Institution. In case if Institution becomes unable to enhance such setup, it would work with the Institution to secure external arrangements to meet such deficits and extra costs for industrial deputation. The cost of such external arrangements shall be borne by the Institution.

b) Mobilization and Registration of students

It will be the responsibility of the selected Institution to have a registration desk immediate after the orientation session to facilitate registration.

Marketing activities like banners, brochures and leaflets can also be distributed to promote registration of students.

c) Batch formation and training calendar

The Training Partner allocated in each college/ district will joint work out a batch plan and training calendar for each college.

d) Appointment of dedicated Nodal Person

A dedicated Nodal Person will have to be appointed for the project.

The Nodal Person will provide periodical updates to Institution team.

e) Provide course material and session plan.

Training Partner may print and/or provide soft copy, as appropriate, the required course material and distribute among the students.

The session plan will be developed to suit time-table changes.

The session plan will include all components of skill based training with a clear schedule of training and assessment.



f) Delivery of trainings (Theory and Practical)

The Training Partner will ensure delivery of theory component as per the curriculum provided. It is mandatory to include practical, hands on training sessions so that the students can practice the learnt concepts of the job role. The Institution will have to be innovative to install hand-on training/demo set ups for the students.

g) Reporting and Monitoring

The training partner should ensure that:

- Providing periodical progress reports to Institution and colleges
- Compliance to Institution processes of entering details in the required format
- Prior information to Institution for assessment and certification.

h) Fee Collection

The selected Institution will collect the training fee directly from the student. All such Fees shall be collected on behalf of and in name of training partner shall remit into the bank account of training partner.

i) Assessment and Certification

The performance of the students will be assessed/ examined by the training team. The students will be awarded certificates as per template of certificates approved by the institution and training partner mutually.

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

The Parties shall use their best efforts to settle amicably all disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement or the interpretation thereof. If any dispute, difference, question or disagreement arises between the Parties hereto or their respective representatives or assignees, in connection with construction, meaning operation, effect interpretation of the Agreement or breach thereof which Parties are unable to settle mutually within 30 days from the commencement of settlement proceedings, the same shall be referred to Arbitration.

CONFIDENTIALITY:

None of the parties shall disclose to any person or use for any purpose any confidential information of the other as a result of entering into this Agreement. The Institution without prior permission in written with the training partner should not use any course content, material, presentation etc., either directly or indirectly for any purpose.



VALIDITY & TERMINATION:

The validity of this MoU shall be **Two Years** initially from the date of signing the same and thereafter extended through mutual consent.

This MoU could be terminated by giving a notice of 1 month from either side, however the first right of refusal / acceptance shall be that of the Training Partner.



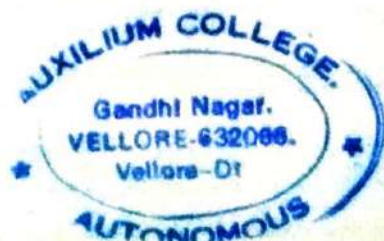

PURPOSE


Whereas

- a) SHC Sacred Heart College (Autonomous) (SHC) is an affiliated First Grade College of Thiruvalluvar University. As the motto of the College acclaims "*ad omne opus bonum instructi*" (Ready for every good work), this noble institution began its good work from its inception in 1951 in reaching out and imparting quality education to the rural community of students, first generation learners and the economically and socially deprived learners. Founded by a Spanish missionary, Rev. Fr. Joseph Carreno, SDB, the college then functioned with only 10 teachers and 81 students. Now as it approaches its seventh decade in existence it offers 15 Under Graduate (UG) programmes, 14 Post Graduate (PG) programmes and 7 Post Graduate Diploma programmes. It also offers 12 M.Phil. programmes and 12 Ph.D. programmes, catering towards producing professionals with high level of ethical and moral conduct, and excellence in their academic pursuit.
- b) SHC is desirous to associate with DBC on various areas as discussed in the Purview of this MoU, which will be mutually beneficial to both organizations.

- c) Don Bosco College, Dharmapuri, a constituent of an Educational Network of the Salesians of Don Bosco, Chennai Province, Tamil Nadu, was founded in 2007 on Adhiyaman Bypass Road, Sogathur, by Rev. Fr. Johnson Antonysamy, SDB, Rector and Rev. Dr. C. M. Varghese, SDB, the first Principal. It is the first and only minority institution, established in Dharmapuri to train and equip the young minds for a challenging and fulfilling career under Periyar University, Salem. Built in a serene and calm environment, the College provides a holistic ambient for the growth of the rural students.

The academic journey of the College commenced with 5 Undergraduate courses, 9 teaching faculty, 3 support staff and 258 students. In the past 12 years, the College has grown in various dimensions and has been tirelessly proceeding to achieve its goal. At present, the College has 2,523 students, 107 teaching faculty and 32 support staff, with 11 Undergraduate courses, 8 Postgraduate courses and 4 M.Phil. courses. The vast majority of our students hail from Dharmapuri and Krishnagiri districts, while students from other parts of Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Andamans and North East also are accommodated. The College takes pride in educating numerous first general graduates. The medium of instruction and evaluation is English.

In the past few years, the College has grown considerably as the result of collective efforts of many, including Salesians, staff and well-wishers. A number of significant additions have been made to the infrastructure with an open auditorium, garden at the front yard of the College, compound wall with gates, state of the art computer and science laboratories, a well-furnished library with a reading hall, a Bosco Bicentenary Hall and a modern canteen. As well, we provide separate hostel facility for girls and excellent transport services to the remote villages.

1. OBJECTIVE:

3. AREAS OF CO-OPERATION:

- g) Whereas, SHC and DBC recognize that the academic collaboration would be of mutual benefit and would provide strengths in research and education and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation. As per the purpose of the said agreement, the two parties shall:
- i. Research Collaborations: Faculty / Researchers / Students of SHC and DBC can collaborate in future research projects that either involve working cooperatively with partner institutions and / or cover a research topic with an international component. Activities include, but are not limited to, efforts toward developing proposals for collaborative research, co-authoring publication, conducting joint research projects, or establishing joint research centers etc.
 - ii. Faculty Exchange with Partner Universities: Faculty members of SHC and DBC can travel between to participate in activities that can enhance their international / national experience and knowledge and also to foster relations between the parties. Activities include, but are not limited to, delivering lectures, teaching a course, taking a sabbatical, acquiring skills for institutional governance and developing collaborative research etc.
 - iii. Student Exchange with Partner Universities: Students can be given an opportunity to travel among parties to participate in activities / events that will enhance their international / intercultural experience and knowledge.
 - iv. Promotion of integrated studies for related studies: The parties can look at integrating an international / intercultural dimension into their teaching, research, and service functions of the university which would enable the students understanding on a global perspective.
 - v. Cooperate in the exchange of information relating to their activities in teaching and research in fields of mutual interests; sharing best practices adopted by each parties; sharing of e-content between the parties; access to library and repository services, if possible.
 - vi. Conduct cultural projects, study tours, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.
- ❖ To promote and enhance academic, research interest between SHC & DBC.
 - ❖ To provide summer training for UG and PG students during their course and providing professional manpower to support the programme.
 - ❖ Provide academic interaction by delivering special lecturers at SHC & DBC on topics of relevance to current research trends.

- ❖ Organizing and participating in joint Symposia/Conferences/Workshop/Short term refresher courses.
- ❖ Exchange of faculty for guest lectures.
- ❖ This Memorandum of Understanding shall be valid from the date of signing of the same.

4. FUNDING:


- h) Expenses for airfare, transportation, room and board and personal expenses of exchange students, teachers or officers shall be covered by each individual. Students will pay their registration, courses or professional practices at their home university, so that they can be recognized afterwards.
- i) Students, interns and officers shall be responsible for requesting and obtaining lodging by inquiring with the university, which shall provide every help necessary for them to obtain safe, convenient lodging arrangements.
- j) Financial expenses for (term visits) internships of professors and researchers, which will be arranged at the parties' request, as well as travel expenses, shall be covered by the requesting institution. No fees will be paid, as the assumption is that the professors /researchers remain in their positions at their home institution, which will continue to pay their salaries.
- k) Students, professors and officers must acquire a medical insurance policy. The universities may offer them advice in seeking appropriate insurance.

Either party may propose to the other a modification of the Agreement at any time in writing.

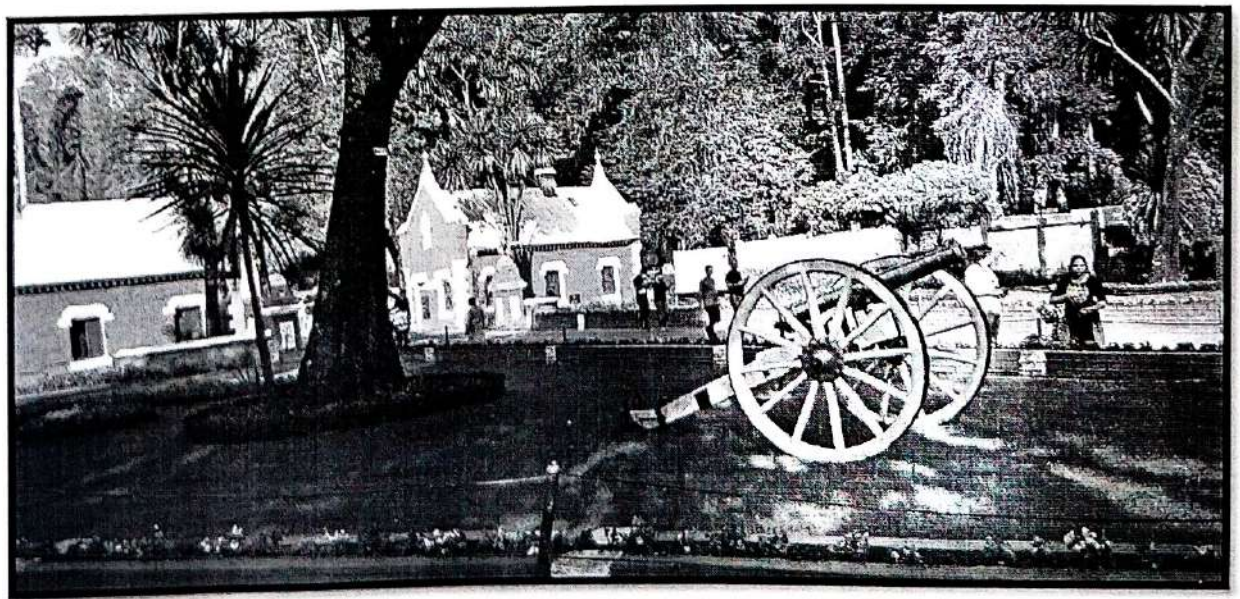
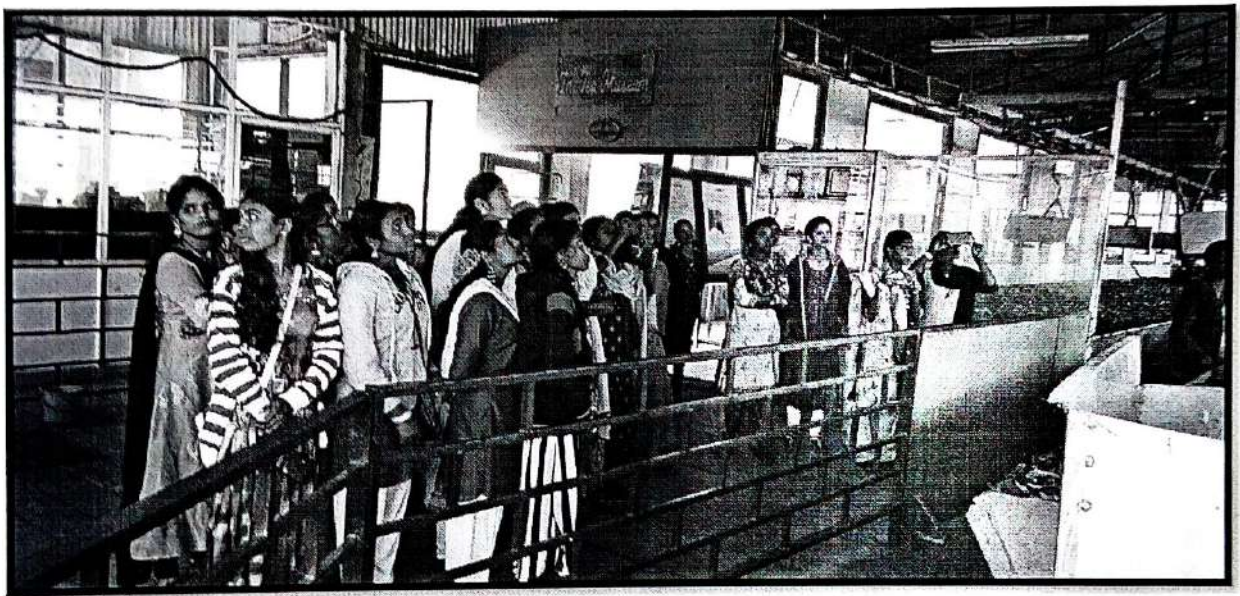
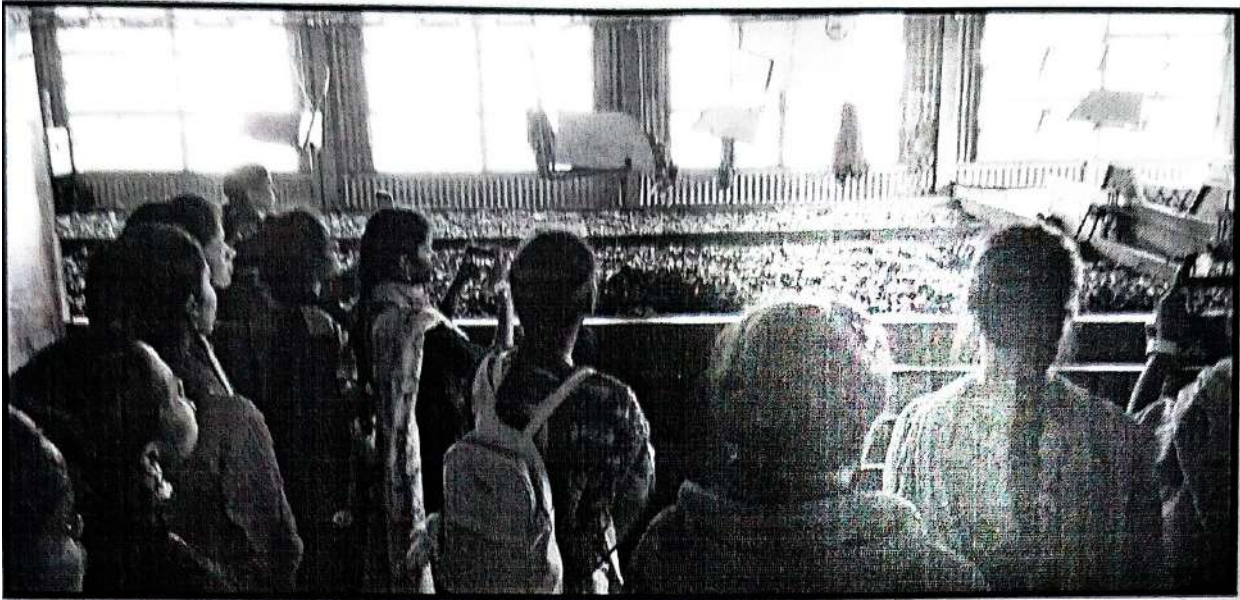
The department of commerce Don Bosco College organized a one day's Industrial visit to OOTY, on 21th April 2022 for all the commerce department girls students.
