


After the second session, students understood what are the difficulties are there in marketing and how to handle the issue in marketing.

Fr. Francis Xavier spoke, about the meaning and definition of digital print media, the significant role of visual designing in that, and then the deference between the both clearly.



The session was successfully ended with the vote of thanks given by our Department Association President, Mr.M.Sedhupathi.



Evaluation:


- ♦ The workshop was very effective and learning experience.







