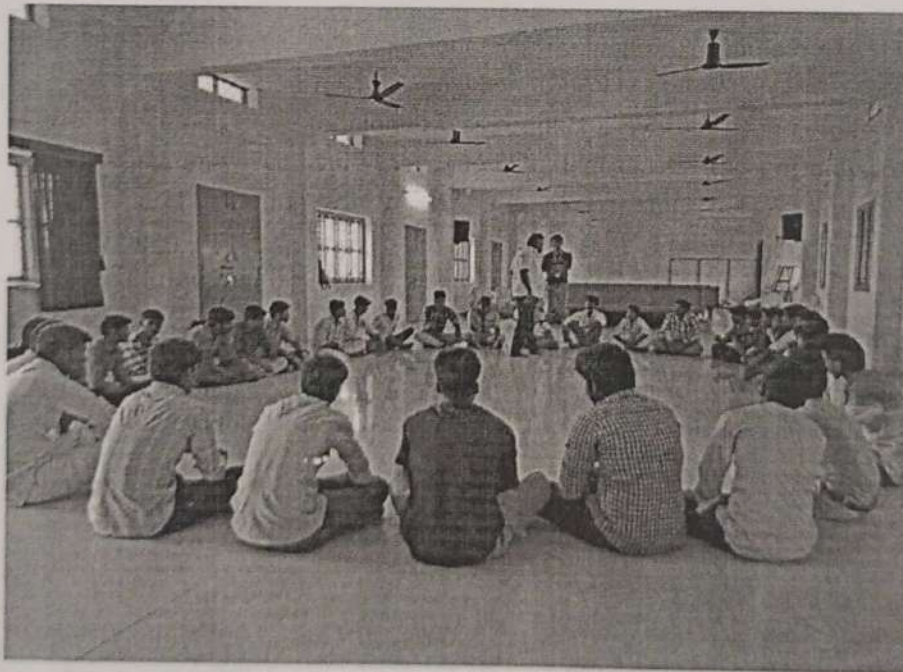


Report on one day workshop on "TAMIL TRADITIONAL FOLK ARTS TRAINING"

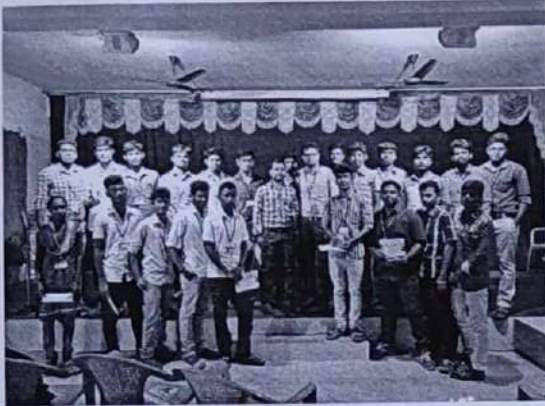
POSTER DESIGNING COMPETITION

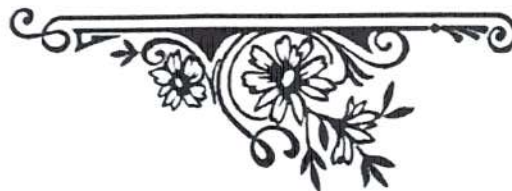


REPORT ON PRE – CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

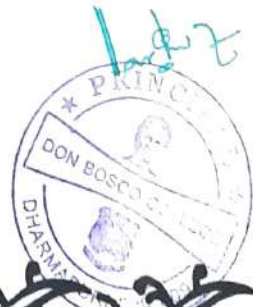

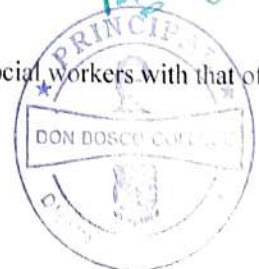
