

We, the Salesians of Don Bosco, take this opportunity to acknowledge the **Almighty God** for His abundant blessings and divine guidance of our Patron, **Saint John Bosco**.

I take immense pleasure in presenting the **14**th **Annual Report** of the College documenting its developments and achievements for the year 2021-2022.

Don Bosco College was established in 2007 with **258 students** and at present it has 1590 **students**, with 11 Undergraduate Courses, 8 Postgraduate Courses and 4 Research Courses for M.Phil and **Ph.D in Commerce**. The College comprises of **5 in the board of Management**, **86 teaching faculty**, **19 support staff**, **12 drivers and and 6 hygiene care workers**.

For this year, **Rev. Fr. Dr. Edwin George** continues heading the College as Secretary and Rector, and **Rev. Dr. A. Siluvai Muthu** as Principal of the College. **Rev. Fr. John** took charge as the Director of Don Bosco College of Education. **Rev. Fr. Anto Sagayaraj** serves as the Administrator. **Rev. Fr. Antony Kishore**, serves as the Vice-Principal and as an Assistant Professor in the department of Social work. Dr. I. James and Mrs. D.S. Sumathi continue working as Deans of Students.

On behalf of the Salesian community, I sincerely appreciate **Rev. Dr. K. Jayaprakash, Rev. Fr. Samson Shanmugam** and **Rev. Fr. Antony Raj** and all the out gone staff for their help and earnest service to the College.

DEVELOPMENTS

We deliberately focus on developing the infrastructure of the College every year. This year, we bought **systems** for computer lab and provided **hostel facility** for boys as well as sports students. Floor wise drinking water facility is made in six places. Due to Covid Situation many developmental works which was planned could not be executed.

We received various scholarships of Governmental and Non-governmental, to a tune of **Rs.40,00,000**. Indeed, we are delighted by the generosity of **Mr. Kulandai Francis**, Founder and President of IVDP, Krishnagiri, for his financial support to our orphan and semi-orphan students to the tune of **Rs.7,50,000**. Above all, Don Bosco Foundation, Chennai and DBC Management financially support our poor students and also for all the first year students **first semester fee is waived off** due to the Pandemic situation for the past two years. The management is generous enough to do this though there is a heavy loss of revenue nearly **one crore** every year.

Towards an inclusive education, all the new staff members are orientated on Salesian Preventive Education System and Organised Salesian Educative Pastoral Council (SEPC) meeting along with Student representatives, faculties and stake holders. Above all, our Provincial, **Rev. Fr. K.M. JOSE's** extraordinary visitation on 30th and 31st of March 2022 and being present here now with us gives an energetic overtone.

THE UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION RESULTS

The Overall University Examinations Pass Percentage is 100%.

LIBRARY AND LABORATORY

The College library has a collection of about **16,143 books**. It subscribes to **382 bound periodicals**, **19 Magazines**, **24 Journals** and **9 News Papers**. Every year we spend more than one lakh rupees on buying new books.

The Computer Laboratory with **205 computers** is connected in a local area network with a central server system.

Concurrently, we have equipped Chemistry Lab, Physics Lab and Digital Print Media Lab well with more recent apparatus and also bent on providing lab facility for Allied Botany for Chemistry students.

Our College won **Second Place** in the Fr. **Guezou Memorial open to all Volley Ball Tournament at Yelagiri Don Bosco College** with total participants of twenty colleges.

CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

In conjunction with regular classes and timely completion of syllabus, the formation of students was ensured through Student Induction Programme and Subject Bridge Course, orientation programmes for the new faculty and fresh students, extra coaching classes for the advance learners, remedial classes for the slow learners, regular Unit Tests, Cycle Tests and Model Exams to measure the internal academic performances of students and counselling and guidance for building a healthy relationship with others. Along with the curricular activities, Moral Education Classes and Skill classes like Employability Course, Technical Skills, Communicative skill and Certificate courses are also conducted to the students.
